

Quarterly Feed Production Statistics for the Quarter ending June 2022 Executive Summary

These statistics report the total tonnage of manufactured animal feed and total tonnage of raw materials used in feed production. This report does not include blended feed.

Some observations:

There was an increase in an imported palm kernel for the current quarter by 12.6% to 495,686 tonnes compared to the same quarter of last year.

No cotton seeds were imported for the current quarter.

Maize decreased by 34% to 18,766 tons while Wheat and Barley use increased by 12% to 115,252 tons and 5% to 24,392 tons respectively as compared to the same quarter of last year. Plant protein soya meal usage decreased by 1% to 37,616 tons compared to the June quarter 2021.

Please note all figures reported in the tables below in this Executive Summary are in metric tonnes (unless otherwise specified).
